



## Franklin's Fantastic Foods

### Ribollita

Today's recipe is an Italian stew dish!

### Ingredients:

- 1/2 pound dried white beans (Cannellini or Great Northern) [Can use canned if in a pinch]
- Kosher Salt
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup good olive oil, extra for serving
- 1/4 pound large diced pancetta or smoked bacon
- 2 cups chopped yellow onion (2 onions)
- 1 cup chopped carrots (3 carrots)
- 1 cup chopped celery (3 stalks)
- 3 tablespoons minced garlic (6 cloves)
- 1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 1 (28-ounce) can Italian plum tomatoes
- 6 cups chicken stock
- 4 cups coarsely chopped or shredded cabbage, optional
- 4 cups coarsely chopped kale
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh basil leaves
- 4 cups sourdough bread cubes, no crust
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup fresh grated parmesan, for serving

### **Directions**:

- 1. In a large bowl, cover the beans with cold water by 1-inch and cover with plastic wrap. Allow to soak overnight in the refrigerator. (Can skip if using canned beans)
- 2. Drain the beans and place them in a large pot with 8 cups of water, bring to a boil. Lower the heat and simmer uncovered for 45 minutes. Add 1 teaspoon of salt and continue to simmer for about 15 minutes, until the beans are tender. Set the beans aside to cool in their liquid.
- 3. Meanwhile, heat the oil in a large stockpot. Add the pancetta and onions and cook over a medium-low heat for 7 to 10 minutes, until the onions are translucent. Add the carrots, celery, garlic, 1 tablespoon of salt, the pepper and red pepper flakes. Cook over medium-low heat for 7 to 10 minutes, until the vegetables are tender. Add the tomatoes with their puree, the cabbage, if using, the kale and the bail and cook over medium-low heat, stirring occasionally for another 7 to 10 minutes.

- 4. Drain the beans, reserving their cooking liquid. Using a food processor puree half of the beans with a little of their liquid. Add to the stockpot along with the rest of the beans. Pour the remaining cooking liquid into a large measuring up and add enough chicken stock to make 8 cups. Add to soup and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer over low for 20 minutes.
- 5. Add the bread to the soup and simmer for 10 more minutes. Taste for seasoning and serve hot in a large bowl sprinkled with parmesan and drizzled with olive oil.

## Ask Nat

Salutations to all aspiring entomologists! We asked you to bring us photos of any scrumpt... err interesting-looking bugs you come across for identification. Read on to find out more about the critters ACC users have encountered.

### **Oil beetle - BlueFoxCat**



Don't let appearances fool you. This beetle, one of the *Meloe* genus of oil beetles, is aptly named. When disturbed, they release an oily substance from their joints that can cause blistering and burning. If that's not enough, the larvae of oil beetles are parasitic on various species of bees. They'll hitch rides on the adult bees back to their hive and then take advantage of the brood cells where larval bees are being raised. Sometimes the provisions for the bee larva are enough, but others the beetle larva will consume the bee larva. Unlike most other metamorphosing insects, oil beetle larvae take various forms at different larval stages to match the task at hand.

### Small tortoiseshell - HerrKrask



The small tortoiseshell butterfly, *Aglais urticae*, is found in most of Europe and northern Asia. While the tops of its wings are brightly colored, the underside is far more drab to allow for camouflage. Eggs are laid on nettles, which the larvae then feed on. Adults feed on nectar and may hibernate through the winter.

### Rosy maple moth - Kellsi A.



The rosy maple moth, *Dryocampa rubicunda*, is a type of silk moth. It lays its eggs on maple trees, the leaves of which the larvae then feed on. Adults do not feed, and as a result have reduced mouthparts and digestive tract. The bright coloration may actually serve as a form of camouflage, resembling the seed pods of certain maple trees.



### Tarantula-hawk wasp and tarantula - Katelyn G.

Many wasps are parasitic, and the tarantula-hawk wasps (genera *Pepsis* and *Hemipepsis*) are no exception. Females seek out tarantulas, like this member of the genus *Aphonopelma*, and sting them with a paralyzing toxin rendering it unable to fight back. The wasp then drags it to a previously prepared burrow, lays an egg, and then covers the burrow. Once the egg hatches, the larva burrows into the tarantula, which is still alive, and consumes it. In order to keep the tarantula alive for as long as possible, the larva avoids vital organs. Eventually the larva will pupate, later emerging as an adult and leaving the burrow. As an adult, the wasp will feed on nectar and fermenting fruit. Tarantula-hawk wasps are considered to have one of the most painful stings of any insect, although they tend to only sting when provoked.

### 4. Who is your favorite Animal Crossing character and why?


